ART GALLERY

"Looking for entries which explore the idea of books evolving beyond their conventional physical and conceptual boundaries"

ENTRY

Entry to the 'Books...beyond words' evolution Award is via a pre selection process.

Artists may enter up to three works, each of which must

- Be the original work of the Entrant
- Have been completed within the two years prior to the closing date
- Not infringe copyright, and
- Not have previously shown at East Gippsland Art Gallery (EGAG)

The Artist must submit on a CD formatted for PC

- A completed entry form for each work.
- 4 views of each work entered 10cm x 15cm, formatted as TIFF files (300 dpi), or high resolution JPEG files.
- A statement of not more than 1500 characters (approx 250 words) about each of the works, and how the Award theme is interpreted. This statement should not include any information which identifies the artist.

One \$A25 non refundable entry fee paid by cheque, or money order should be made payable to the East Gippsland Art Gallery and enclosed with the entry.

Entry forms are available from EGAG website on the Artists' Book Award page.

Entries and fees must be received at EGAG by 5th April 2011

Late entries will not be accepted

Late payment of entry fees will not be accepted

Incomplete entries will not be accepted

Alterations to the formatting of forms may result in an entry being ineligible for consideration by the judges.

Submission of an Entry will be deemed to be acceptance of these Terms and Conditions

A stamped self addressed envelope must be supplied by the Artist if discs are to be returned, or receipts are required.

It is the Artists responsibility to ensure that artworks do not violate libel, defamation, character or copyright laws.

By completing the entry form, signing the artist's declaration, and making the work available for exhibition, the Artist

- Agrees to the terms and conditions of the Award, and
- Agrees to allow EGAG to reproduce images of the artwork(s) for purposes of promotion, news reporting, and review up to and for the duration of the event

ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

Entry is open to all Artists, however only residents of the East Gippsland Shire will be eligible for the East Gippsland Artist

Award. Evidence of residency may be requested by EGAG Committee of Management. Award Committee members may enter the Award but if selected will only be eligible for judging in the East Gippsland Artist Acquisitive Award.

MEDIUM

Works may be in any medium but living matter will not be accepted unless the written agreement of EGAG has been obtained by the Artist...

ENTRIES FROM OVERSEAS

Overseas artists should consider Australian Customs & Biosecurity requirements prior to despatching their works.

SELECTION OF WORKS

An appointed selection panel will view all images and artist statements prior to selection of works for exhibition from the eligible entries received. All works selected for exhibition must remain on show for the duration. Decisions made by the Selection Panel, Award Committee, or EGAG Staff are final and no discussion or correspondence will be entered into.

Artists selected for exhibition will be required

- To pay an additional fee of \$25 for one item and \$10 for each additional item to a maximum of \$ 45.
- To supply a signed Artist Declaration

Artists will be notified of selection or non selection for exhibition by email. Discs to be returned will be posted at this time. Artists selected to exhibit their works will receive a hard copy of the 'Information for exhibiting artists' kit, & an invoice for exhibition fees.

EXHIBITION FEE

The non-refundable exhibition fee is additional to the entry fee.

No GST applies to fees

Payments should be made to 'East Gippsland Art Gallery'

JUDGING

Prior to the exhibition opening the Judges will

- View all works on display and select one entry for the Major Award
- Choose the other Awards from the remaining eligible entries

The decision of the Judges will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into. The Judges and EGAG reserve the right to withhold any Award.

PREPARATION OF ARTWORKS

- All works must be presented ready for exhibition
- Any special instructions should be included with the work

- Artists Name, Collaborator Names, Contact Details, Price of the Work or NFS, Description Details and Title must be completed on the exhibition entry form (available on EGAG website)
- Artists should indicate if works are to be shown under glass, or may be handled with gloves.
- Price of work must include an additional 15% for gallery commission
- Entries selected for exhibition must be accompanied by a signed Artists Declaration (available on EGAG website)
- Works requiring specialized display fixtures or fittings must be clearly identified and will be considered at the discretion of the EGAG. Special fixtures may need to be provided by the Artist.
- Any electrical equipment required to display work must be supplied by the Artist and must display a current electrical safety test tag.
- Artworks submitted without full information and documentation may be excluded from the Award

TRANSPORT AND INSURANCE

Arrangements for forward & return freight and associated costs for transportation of the Works are the responsibility of the Artist.

Payment of any expenses associated with Customs and/or Quarantine clearances for the Works are the responsibility of the Artist.

Adequate packaging and postage is to be provided by the Artist for the works to be returned by post. EGAG will take the greatest care with all exhibits but accepts no liability for damage or loss incurred to works at any time including in transit.

COLLECTION OF WORKS

Artworks are to be collected from EGAG by **4pm on 16th September 2011**. Works to be returned by prepaid or COD mail or courier service will be despatched during this week. Works which remain uncollected or those submitted with inadequate return freight & packaging will be deemed abandoned and dealt with in accordance with all applicable laws.
