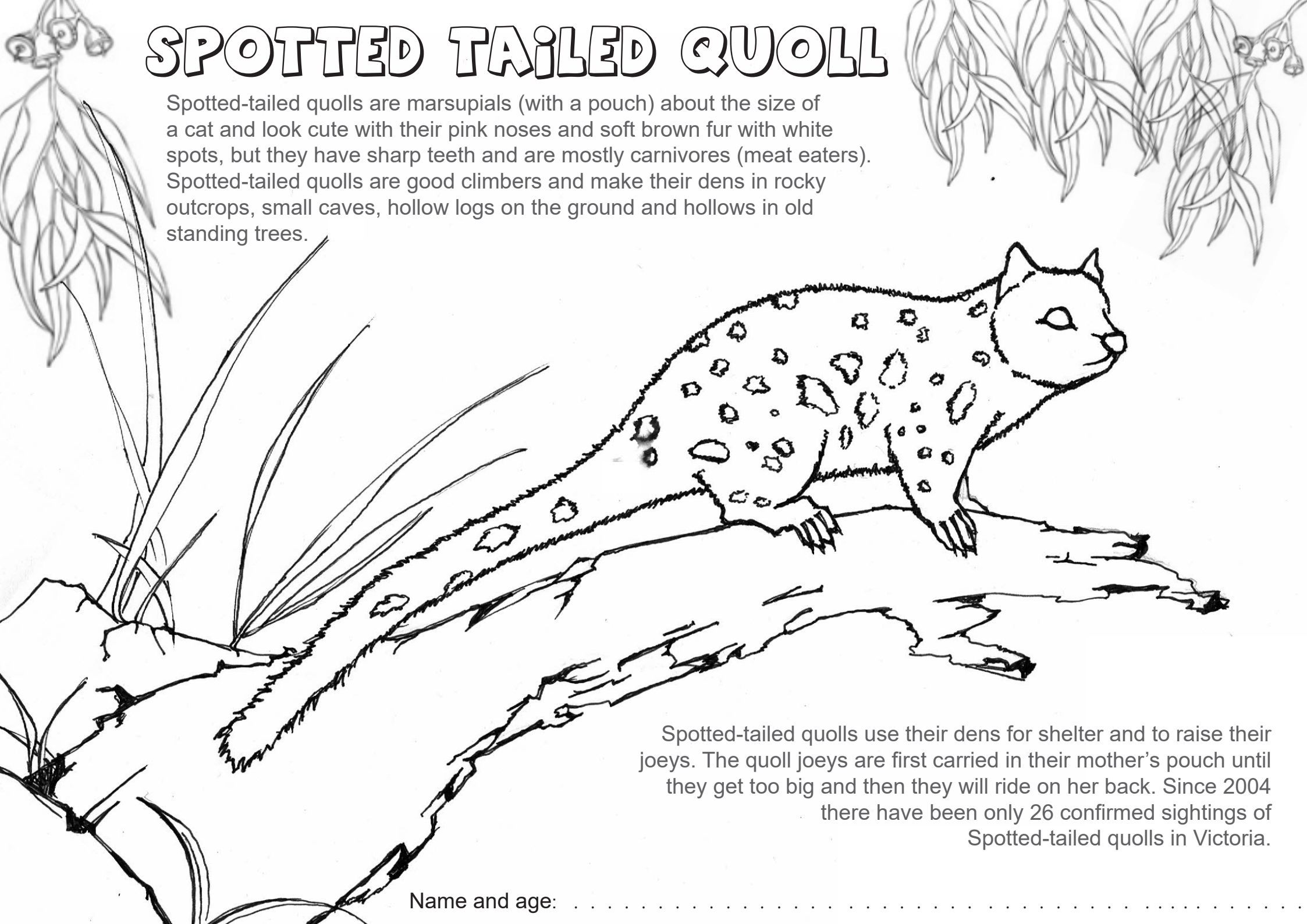


SPOTTED TAILED QUOLL

Spotted-tailed quolls are marsupials (with a pouch) about the size of a cat and look cute with their pink noses and soft brown fur with white spots, but they have sharp teeth and are mostly carnivores (meat eaters). Spotted-tailed quolls are good climbers and make their dens in rocky outcrops, small caves, hollow logs on the ground and hollows in old standing trees.



Spotted-tailed quolls use their dens for shelter and to raise their joeys. The quoll joeys are first carried in their mother's pouch until they get too big and then they will ride on her back. Since 2004 there have been only 26 confirmed sightings of Spotted-tailed quolls in Victoria.
